

Technical Brochure for the Engagy360 Service

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How is the Engagy360 service hosted?

Engagy360 is provided as Software-as-a-Service (SaaS): the central part of the service is hosted by the provider. On the customer's side, it is only necessary to configure permissions and install the SPFx application in SharePoint and Teams.

Where is the data stored?

Resource	Location	Notes
Azure SQL	West Europe	Licence information, information about the customer's SharePoint environment, information about portals and sites, site templates, editors' tasks, site metrics reports and notifications.
Azure Storage Account (Tables)	West Europe	Information about operations performed in the customer's environment, such as installations and updates of SharePoint applications.
Azure Storage Account (Blob containers)	West Europe	Image files used by customers to generate visual themes. Source files provided by customers in the portal generation process.
Azure Application Insights	West Europe	Service logs
Azure Key Vault	West Europe	Operations in the customer's environment are performed on behalf of the user; users' access tokens are stored in Azure Key Vault.
Azure OpenAI	Sweden Central	Prompts and generated responses are retained by Microsoft for up to 30 days to prevent abuse and the generation of harmful content. The data is not shared with other services and is not used to train OpenAI or Azure OpenAI models. Customer data is protected by the backup mechanisms of the Azure services that hold it; those backups are deleted automatically within 35 days after the data is deleted.

5. Reduced-permission mode

By default, Engagy360 uses application permissions at the *FullControl* level across the customer's entire SharePoint environment. Alternatively, the application can run in reduced-permission mode, using only the application permission *Sites.Selected*. In this mode, the following are required:

- *Read* permission on the SharePoint admin site,
- *FullControl* permission on each site registered with the service.

These permissions are granted during:

- registration of the customer's environment (on the admin site),
- registration of each individual site with the service.

The application switches to reduced-permission mode automatically if its *FullControl* permissions are revoked in Entra ID.

In this mode, some operations may be limited, because the application must work strictly within the permissions of the current user — particularly for operations on sites not registered with the service and when creating new sites.

User identifiers from Entra ID	For the term of the agreement	Attributes identifying users in various data entities.
Access tokens	Temporary	Users' access tokens used for long-running operations, stored in Azure Key Vault for the duration of the operation.

Processing in cache and working memory

Information about users that is displayed in the user interface or used by service features is retrieved on the basis of the stored Entra ID user identifiers.

Basic personal information obtained on the basis of those identifiers, such as display name, first name, last name, login and email address, may exist temporarily in the browser cache of users of the service and in the working memory of the server hosting the service, for no longer than 5 minutes.

Content entered by users

The service stores data entered by users or relating to the customer's environment, which may contain substantive information, including unstructured personal data.

	Temporary	Source information files provided by customers in the portal generation process. Stored until the portal is created or the portal draft is deleted.
